Sunday 25th Aug 2013. First riders at 10:30am or afterwards in your own time. Last rider away by 12:30pm.





Broughton Castle is situated approx. 3 miles west of Banbury off the B4035. Please take the North Newington turn and follow signs to the Horse Ride car park

at the back of the castle grounds.

The course is approximately 10 miles around the grounds of Broughton Castle and adjoining countryside. A shorter ride is available. Hats and back protectors must be worn on the XC course and all jumping completed at owners' risk.
